Summary

Christianity is all about you working the Word of God in your life. It has to grow out of your life. There is nothing about your life that doesn't have its foundations in the Word. God's Word speaks to every area of your life. Every day when we open our eyes in the morning, we need to ask God what He wants us to do. We need to inquire of Him for even the little decisions in our day to day lives. Jesus said that He only said what the Father said and did what the Father did. Do we live like that? It is possible! When we can get to that place then the glory of God will be manifested in our lives like never before! You have to get to a place where you are hearing the Father! What is He saying for you to do? You will never hear a word from the Father if you haven't cultivated a relationship with the Word. If you are determined enough to have God speak in your life you are going to want to stay in the Word! For some reason we want to hear the audible voice of God. The silent voice of God in your spirit is more real than any audible voice of God. Your spirit man is alive! When you read the Bible, God is talking! It is not the memory of the Word that sustains you. You feed yourself through your eyes. You don't feed yourself through your memory. It is the Word that gives you life, not the food you eat. You've got to spend the time in the word. God can then begin to reveal Himself more and more. You have to give it attention! What is more important to you? Is watching TV more important? Are you doing the work? Are you waking up every morning and speaking the Word? Are you working this Word? If we don't there is no glory in our lives. The more glory we desire, the more work we have to do in this Word. How much are you hungry for the full manifestation of the glory of God in your life?

- A. Christianity Is All About You Working The Word of God In Your Life
 - a. It has to grow out of your life.

 - B. There Is Nothing About Your Life That Doesn't Have Its Foundations in the Word.
 - a. God's Word speaks to every area of your life.
 - i. We live our lives like that isn't true. It is everything about your life.
 - ii. You have to take what He speaks and put it into your heart and manifest that. He speaks to us about everything! He speaks about being joyful, about being good to people, He speaks about caring.
 - iii. You are actually doing the Word when you do those things! What time to leave the house in the morning is doing His Word! He is speaking to you!
 - iv. The Words that I speak unto you are spirit and life! His words are living and they give life. We have to get in touch with that reality.
 - v. Can anyone live like that living every day asking God about every move you make? It seems hard but here's the reality. It's the easiest thing to do.

- vi. It's easier than you doing it on your own. It doesn't seem like it because you've done it on your own for so long. But when it becomes too weighty, too much for you to handle like the cancer or the bank taking the house away is when we think we need to do it. We will never be able to do it then if we haven't done it by asking when to leave the house in the morning. You can't do it if you can't say, "What can I buy God?" Or "how much should I give my brother Lord?" We think the manifestation of those great problems is what God is interested in and not the day to day living.
 - vii. God is interested in our day to day living. That's why the bible says it's from glory to glory. Dependent on Him from everything in our lives.
- C. Jesus Said Only What the Father Said and Did What the Father Did
- a. Was He totally dependent like He said He was? Do we live like that? Is it impossible to live like that?
 - b. Jesus is the prototype. He is the example. That's why He said in the end that if we live like that then even greater works will we do!
 - c. We think it's too much of a burden to do everything that God tells us to do.
 - d. Jesus relied on every word the Father said. We have got to get to a place that when we open up our eyes in the morning, everything that we do, every step that we take, it is "what is the Father saying?"
 - e. When we can get to that place then the glory of God will be manifested in our lives like never before. That everything we say will manifest!
 - f. There is nothing that Jesus said that didn't happen! There is nothing that Jesus did that wasn't supposed to happen like it did!
 - g. You have to know that God wants to do that with you just like He did that with Jesus! We need to say, "not my will but Yours be done."
 - h. You have to get to a place where you are hearing the Father! What is He saying for you to do? We don't want to give an ear. You have got to receive your hearing by faith!
- D. You Will Never Hear A Word From the Father if You Haven't Cultivated a Relationship With the Word.
- a. The Bible will never grow old.
 - b. It has a message for everything about your life.
 - c. If you are determined enough to have God speak in your life you are going to want to stay in the Word!
 - d. We want to hear the audible voice of God.
 - e. The silent voice of God in your spirit is more real than any audible voice of God. Your spirit man is alive! When you read the Bible, God is talking!
 - f. Take what He's saying and put it in your heart and let it manifest! That's how the Father gets glorified! By the Word coming out of our lives!
- E. Everything About Creation or Creating is About Manifestation – Genesis 1:1
- a. The greatest manifestation is the Word. Every time God said, it manifested. Then God looked at the manifestation and said it was good.
- F. In the Beginning God Created Light
- a. What was that light that God created?
 - i. He creates the sun and the moon later on.

- ii. The glory is the manifestation of the Word. The Word can never manifest without revelation. There is no manifestation of healing unless you know that the Word of God says “you are healed”. They all work together: the Word, the revelation, the understanding, the manifestation of the Word of God is the light.
 - iii. God is light. In Him there is no darkness. When God said “let there be light” He was releasing a measure of Himself in spirit, in word and in manifestation all set up ready for everything else to be created.
 - iv. This is what we call His glory. This is what Adam and Eve lived in. They were so conscious of the spirit part of them that that which was natural was not the focus. The glory of God that was there in the beginning covered everything. It was all they ever needed and wanted.
 - v. From glory to glory. Let there be man was a greater manifestation of glory! That’s how He works. He releases a measure of glory and then uses that same glory to release a greater manifestation of glory!
 - vi. The first thing that God was concerned about was His glory. It is the most important thing. That’s why satan has used the thing that’s the most important to bring the greatest confusion.
- G. It’s Not the Memory of the Word That Sustains You
- a. What is a staple diet here in Canada? Potatoes. Has the memory of potatoes ever sustained anyone in their flesh? The thought of mashed potatoes, does it make you healthy?
 - b. You feed yourself through your eyes. You don’t feed yourself through your memory. We live a busy life and we rely on our memory.
 - c. You have to put time aside for the Word. You have to feed yourself. It doesn’t work in the natural and it doesn’t work in the spirit.
 - d. You see through your eyes. The eyes are the window to the soul.
 - e. Jesus is the Word of God. It is time to get real with the Word of God. What’s more important, the Word of God or TV? Sports? What’s more important to us?
 - f. We’ve used the excuse, I don’t need to see it because I remember it. Why don’t you remember the game that you’re watching? Because it’s new! The Word of God is new every morning!
 - g. You’ve got to put your spiritual eyes into it! You’ve got to attend to it! It’s important! It requires a giving up of where you’re at and going to that which you need to attend to. The bible says attend unto my words.
 - h. You’ve got to spend the time in the word. God can then begin to reveal Himself more and more. You have to give it attention! You are not relying on yourself. When you pick up the Word God can trust you more and more. He can give us more because He can trust us. It’s so that God can speak to you!
 - i. It’s that attitude that’s required for glory. That glory is God doing the work. We need the attitude of doing all that we can and trust God for the rest. We have to seek Him and have a hunger for Him. We have to get serious. Until I spend the time, until I give all I have, then I’m not serious for the manifestation of this Word. The bible says that we don’t live by bread alone but by every word that comes out of the mouth of God.
- H. Your Physical Body is Not What Gives You Life
- a. Your body is meant to die. It’s meant to get old. Naturally you’re meant to fade. Your cells are consistently dying.

- b. The bible says that the Word is health to our body! Not the food we eat.
 - c. This Word is what is going to take this body and renew it like the eagle! It is the answer to every problem in our lives!
 - d. Are you doing the work? Don't you have a dream that comes from the Word? To be financially prosperous? Are you brainstorming ideas more than speaking this Word? Are you waking up every morning and speaking the Word? Are you working this Word? If we don't there is no glory in our lives. The more glory we desire, the more work we have to do in this Word.
- I. What Are You Doing Before Men?
- a. What is denying Jesus before men?
 - i. When you don't speak the word of truth before men, you've denied him.
 - ii. You must respond with the Word! The sin of omission is sometimes more sinful than the sin of commission.
 - iii. You've got to be consistently responding with the Word if it's real.
 - iv. If we want the glory we have to say and do everything that Jesus said and did. Every time He wanted something, He said.
 - v. We are worried about the world; what they'll think. He can't create by thoughts. He creates by words. We've got to be the same.
 - vi. What is He saying to you and me through His word? We have to be hungry for manifestation to! He wanted it! How much do you want the purposes of God in your life or are you ready to settle? Are you comfortable just relying on yourself? It's worked for you. It's time to forget about that. How much are you hungry for the full manifestation of the glory of God?
